



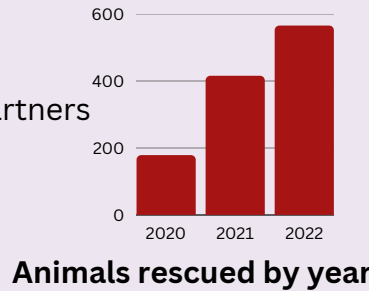
2022 TCHS Impact Statement

565 Animals rescued

- 75 animals adopted locally
- 483 animals placed with regional partners
- 7 animals reclaimed by owners

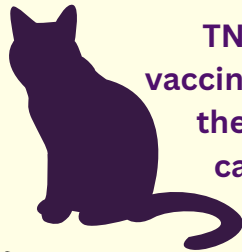
302 pets fostered by our **17** foster heroes

707 Feral cats TNVR'd



TNVR means we trapped, neutered and vaccinated homeless cats before returning them. We always make sure they have a caretaker to provide food and housing (which we can help provide).



340 Pets spayed and neutered

- 277 cats
- 63 dogs

Pet support programs

- 441 vaccinations provided
- 265 dogs and cats microchipped
- 66 emergency veterinary subsidies
- 112 pets given emergency food supplies

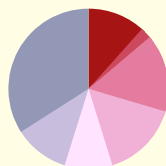
TCHS 2022 Expenses
